Treasurers Update

- Barbara reported that we have received \$347 in donations excluding Grocery Outlet funds.
- We currently have a total of \$6,700 in grant and restricted funds for specific projects. This amount includes the balance of \$1,300 from Grocery Outlet.
 - \$221. spent from CERT money
- \$500 in D2 Leadership money is being held pending decisions about National Night Out, scheduled August 3, pending Covid restrictions.
- Barbara asked about the cost of Zoom and the Website, we may be able to apply those costs to grant money.

• BeautifySJ Grant has been extended to December 2021. In addition to the plants for the Native Garden, we may be able to use the balance of the grant for other park purchases.

Neighborhood Concerns

 Neighborhood Watch: several small groups participating now.

- Unhoused people and police issues for business owners are a concern.
- Walkie Talkies for CERT: We should not use Walkie Talkies for Neighborhood Watch.
- CERT: suggestion to provide First Aid equipment at several houses in the community. Herb will inventory the equipment in the shed.
 - GMRS discussion.
- HomeFirst and LifeMoves: discussion of their needs for food or clothing. Get specific information about Safe Parking Program at Southside. What are the restrictions and offerings?
- Los Paseos Park: water may be an issue over the summer.
- Darkness in the Paseos: discussion about motion detector lights in certain areas. Is it possible to purchase lights and ask homeowners in strategic areas to install on their houses.
 Discussion of how to fund lighting.
- Dog Waste Bag Dispensers: Dispensers are being emptied quickly, not always for immediate dog waste. We may have to consider budgeting for additional bags.
