Crimson Blues Band and the ice cream vendor have committed. We will keep it simple with chalk art contest, packaged snacks, bottled water and a hand washing/sanitizing station. We have posters, banners and NNO Lawn Signs to place. Vendors will have free tables. Barbara will send out and track the budget.

Vendor suggestions include Intero Real Estate, 4H Clubs, Boy Scouts/Cub Scouts and Girl Scout troops, Great Oaks Water, Santa Teresa Library, Green Foothills, Open Space, Home First, Grocery Outlet, WERC, CERT. Barbara will keep a list of committed tables and volunteers.

We also need a sign in sheet and greeter table with snack tickets. We also need volunteers to set up, cleanup and man several LPNA tables.

Opportunity Housing

No neighborhood association except Santa Teresa has officially opposed or approved. Sergio has not made up his mind.

There was a lengthy discussion about the pros and cons.

Policy, following the study, may be written for just transit district areas, although the Task Force says open it up to the entire city.
