Treasurer's Report

- Barbara reported that the 2023 BeautifySJ grant has not been approved or funded. The grant time has been extended but there isn't a lot of information about the status.
- There are questions about UNSCC (United Neighborhoods group), and the insurance coverage tied to that group. Hoping for a resolution mid-summer.
- In the meantime, LPNA has the funds to cover the BBQ planned for June. National Night Out may be an issue without grant monies.

Park Projects

- Barbara reported that the Native Plant Garden is looking good. Some of the seed planted have germinated and the rains have helped with growth. Barbara planted 5 replacement plants and 1 new plant. Peter Chen is helping Barbara with the irrigation project and several other tasks. A drip system, controller and water lines for small plants are coming soon.
- Barbara asked for help watering the trees we recently planted. The trees are doing well; the elms are leafing; the maples are ready to bud, and the oaks are a little behind but healthy.
- Herb reported that gopher eradication is in progress by PRNS.
- Greg is planning to ask PRNS to make the Park Rules more visible.

A resident have requested a dog enclosure at the park. PRNS will do a walk through and study the feasibility and the cost.
