- Barbara will meet with Jen Holst about the garden area. We have \$1,200 in grant money that has not been spent. Barbara and Jen will discuss options.
- LPNA will not participate in April’s Litter Cleanup.
- Herb will contact Councilmember Casey to request \$3,500 in funding for LPNA in lieu of the Beautify SJ grant. Barbara mentioned that 36 NAs who were funded last year did not get funded this year.
- Herb will follow-up with city inspectors about sidewalk repairs in the Paseos. He will also discuss benches for the Paseos.
- The Board thanked Member-at-Large Alan Chan for his constant presence and oversight at Los Paseos Park. Alan performs maintenance tasks, reports damage or suspicious activity, and is a constant and consistent presence in the park.
